Riding on Air Force One does not count. But YOUR MOAA

and Chapter membership DO count. It does make a difference. Help us in recruiting more voices.

Please continue your letter/email campaigns to your legislators, even visit them at their home offices during this recess if you can. Our key issues coming up are:

- 1. Troops Deserve Full Pay Raise and Force Increases
- 2. Reject Military Housing Allowance Cuts
- 3. Oppose Disproportional TRICARE Fee Hikes
- 4. Reduce Military "Widows Tax," Don't Just Maintain It
