Headquarters MOAA was represented by COL USA (Ret) Terri Coles, Senior Director, Council & Chapter Affairs. She listed priority items that MOAA National is working on such as an automation upgrade, expanding Virtual Chapters, taking a relook at JROTC awards programs with a possible late October a new plan. She made every Chapter aware of a new grant program where 2017 was the first year for "Community Outreach" grants up to \$5000.

Later in the day after a visit to Fort William Henry there was the annual Memorial Service to recognize twenty members that had passed since last year's convention. In the evening the the State Council installation of Officers banquet was held where quest speaker retired Air Force Lt. Gen. Dana Atkins, MOAA President and Chief Executive Officer spoke of what MOAA means to him, where he wants to see the organization grow and how they will continually

fight in Washington for military benefits. The installation of New Council officers and the presentation of the Level of Excellence Awards rounded out the evening. Peggy Phillips LTC, USA, (Ret) is your new Council President.

The 1,215-page bill now heads to closed-door negotiations with House lawmakers known as "conference," in which the two versions of the annual policy bill will be combined.
