Female Veterans are at a higher risk; MOAA Senior Staff writer Gina Harkins reports; Women who've served in the military are more likely to suffer from suicidal thoughts, cardiovascular disease, arthritis, and other problems according to a new study looking at the health of female veterans. Female vets report higher rates of cancer, mental illness, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, and depression when compared to women with no military experience, the *Health of Women Who Have Served Report* found. MOAA teamed with United Health Foundation to produce the report.

More than 8 percent of the female veterans surveyed over a four-year period reported having suicidal thoughts in the past year - nearly twice that of their civilian counterparts. About a third reported arthritis, compared to about 26 percent of civilian women. Other findings include: About 13 percent of women who served had cancer, compared with roughly 11 percent of women who did not. Nearly 42 percent reported getting insufficient sleep, compared to 34 percent of civilian women. About a third of female veterans reported mental illness in the last year, compared to about 22 percent of women who didn't serve.
