MOAA message from Forrest Allen:

It's official: The 2019 COLA for military retired pay, Survivor Benefit Plan annuities, Social Security checks, and VA disability and survivor benefits will be 2.8 percent. It will first appear in the January 2019 checks.

<u>MOAA accurately forecasted this final outcome</u> over a month ago based on annual trends and factors such as energy commodities, shelter (housing), and transportation services.

The 2.8 percent 2018 COLA will be the second-largest COLA of the past decade, trailing only the 3.6 percent COLA year of 2011.

Groceries are one of the more than 80,000 items factored into the Bureau of Labor Statistics' (BLS) monthly calculation of the Consumer Price Index (CPI). BLS describes CPI as a measure of the average change over time in the prices paid by urban consumers from around the country for a market basket of consumer goods and services. This basket of goods includes the ordinary items or services you'd expect to use on a daily basis: food and beverages, housing, apparel, transportation, medical care, recreation, or education and communication, among others.

Some of the biggest factors that influence your COLA include the prices of:

- Food
- Clothing
- Housing
- Fuels and transportation fares, and
- Charges for medical services and drugs.
 - President Trump Signs Largest VA Budget in History (MOAA News)
 - President Donald Trump in September signed into the law the largest spending bill in Department of Veterans Affairs history, which includes funding for expanded caregiver and mental health benefits, facility upgrades, and veteran community care programs.
 - "We're fighting to make sure you get the care that you so richly earned," Trump said during a signing ceremony at the VA Southern Nevada Healthcare System in Las Vegas, "and today's legislation is one more promise that the Trump administration is keeping."
 - The <u>VA appropriations bill</u> provides more than \$86 billion for discretionary programs and more than \$110 billion in mandatory benefit payments. It includes several key provisions to benefit veterans, including expansion of mental health services and direct resources for care in rural communities.
 - The bill also provides funds related to the MOAA-supported <u>VA MISSION Act</u>, which will expand comprehensive caregiver services and provide money to modernize medical facilities. It also continues funding for programs that allow veterans to see private-sector doctors in their community if they cannot secure an appointment through the VA in a reasonable amount of time.
 - The bill also puts more than \$1 billion toward the creation and maintenance of an electronic health record system.

Veterans Memorial & Executive Council News: (Repeat)

On Congress Ave. near Genesee St. in Rochester sits the Rapids Cemetery, which dates to the earliest days of city.

It is the final resting place of Revolutionary War, War of 1812, Mexican, Civil, and Spanish-American War veterans. Over the years, the cemetery experienced neglect and decay. It became overgrown with vegetation, and gravestones were toppled, became buried, and even removed entirely. In recent years, the has been a push to restore the cemetery, through a collaboration of the 19th Ward Community Association, the office of the City Historian, the VM&E, and other community groups. Brush has been cleared, buried gravestones located, flowers planted, walkways created and water has been brought to the site. Future plans call for a flagpole, perimeter fencing, historical markers, seating and possibly a gazebo. There are also ongoing efforts to identify individuals buried in currently unmarked graves. As a member organization of the VM&E Council, we have an opportunity to assist in this restoration endeavor. Volunteers are needed to continue the onsite restorations, and monetary donations are needed. For more information on how you can help, contact LTC Russ Green
