Phoenix AZ. MOAA Annual Meeting; What a pleasure to represent the Genesee Valley Chapter during the awards night as this chapter for the eight year in a row was recognized as a "Five Star Chapter". There were 165 chapters receiving a five- or four-star award out of 400 chapters in the United States. The New York State Council of Chapters and four other chapters also received five-star awards. Tim and Jean Vaughn, Jim and Ann Nielsen and Norma

Weissend and her husband Guy were also in attendance for the award ceremony as well as the business meeting the following day Friday November 2nd. Items discussed at the business meeting were that 18 new directors were appointed to the MOAA Board as 18 others terms had expired. The April 2018 "storming of the Hill" resulted in 6.1 million impacts on Twitter and Facebook from 108 contributions or comments. MOAA National member priorities for 2019 are 1. Keeping the members informed. 2. The MOAA Foundation and what it represents and 3. Increasing the opportunity for the MOAA Scholarship Fund to be able to do more with increased donations.

FEDVIP MOAA weekly article: On Monday, November 12th military retirees will begin selecting a new health plan through the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP). FEDVIP offers retirees 10

choices for dental coverage and four vision carriers.

Retirees can make a plan selection and enroll <u>online</u> or over the phone (877-888-3337) from Nov. 12 until Dec. 10. The same phone number can be used by retirees to request a plan comparison from a customer service representative, but officials said retirees must contact plan carriers directly for specific details.

A special comparison chart and FEDVIP guide is included in this month's *Military Officer* magazine, which is delivered to MOAA premium and life members.

Information on plans has been mailed to homes of eligible beneficiaries, officials said, with a second letter in transit and set to arrive by the beginning of open season.

"The availability of new choices in dental and vision coverage is truly a culture change for TRICARE beneficiaries," said Capt. Kathy Beasley, USN (Ret), director of MOAA's government relations health affairs. "Historically, military beneficiaries have always had one plan and one plan only, so there was no choosing between options."

Another significant change with the new coverage plan is the open enrollment season, Beasley said. The defined period to select plans may be the hardest part of the change, she said, and could result in feelings of anxiety for some beneficiaries.

DHA officials encourage beneficiaries to select plans in a timely manner. They expect the final week of open season to be the busiest.

To deal with the anticipated surge, officials have 1,400 customer service representatives in 11 locations across all time zones. They will monitor peak times for phone calls and adjust staffing as needed.

The new plan replaces DHA's Tricare Retiree Dental Program, which ends Dec. 31. Retired uniformed service members and their families who are eligible for the old Tricare plan are eligible to enroll in FEDVIP.

Retirees who have the TRICARE Retiree Dental Plan administered by Delta Dental must enroll during the open season to avoid losing dental coverage Jan. 1. Enrollment, which can be done online or on the phone, ends at midnight Eastern on Dec. 10.

There are some costs associated with FEDVIP. In exclusive provider organizations (EPO) and health maintenance organizations (HMO), the retiree has a fixed copayment for a specific service. An HMO plan also will have an office visit copayment for each dental visit.

There is also a monthly premium for FEDVIP dental plans. In most cases, depending on eligibility and available funds and/or allotments, FEDVIP will set up an allotment automatically with the pay provider to pay for FEDVIP premiums, post-tax.
