Women Veterans' Services

New York State's Division of Veterans' Services has a designated Women Veterans Program Coordinator (WVPC). Additionally, each VA hospital and Community-Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC) has a designated Women Veterans Program Manager who is dedicated to ensuring women get the care they need at any VA facility. Federal Benefits Open Season is Here

November 11 – December 09, 2019 Changes to your TRICARE or FEDVIP plans must be made during open season unless you have a Qualifying Life Event (QLE). A qualifying life event (QLE) includes: retirement, move, marriage, divorce, birth of a child, death of a beneficiary. If you make no changes during Open Season

If you make no changes during Open Season your current enrollment will continue into the next year. However, you may want to review your plan for benefits and premium changes against other plans offered for 2020. Go to: https://www.opm.gov/healthcare-insurance/open-season

Changes to Arlington Cemetery Burial Eligibility Frequently Asked Questions

GVC Member Participates in Repatriation Ceremony in Papua New Guinea

In the accompanying pictures, U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer 3 Ryan Boas, a team leader assigned to the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA), and a soldier with the Papua New Guinea Defense Force (PNGDF), participate in a repatriation ceremony in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea, Sept. 23, 2019. The ceremony, which consisted of two transfer caskets containing the possible remains of service members lost during WWII, was conducted in support of DPAA's mission to provide the fullest possible accounting of our missing personnel to their families and the nation.

In Fiscal Year 2019, DPAA accounted for 218 formerly missing persons from past conflicts, the highest yearly total reached by the agency or its predecessor organizations. Of the 218 newly accounted-for, 140 were from World War II, 73 from the Korean War, and 5 from the Vietnam War, including two civilians who flew for Air America.

CW3 Boas enlisted in the Army in 2003, was later accepted into Warrant Officer Candidate School in 2011 and is currently assigned to the DPAA at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam in Hawaii. He previously had assignments at Ft Huachuca, AZ, Ft Campbell, KY, Ft Jackson, SC, Ft Sill, OK and in Vicenza, Italy.

Additionally, CW3 Boas has deployed four times, two each to Iraq and Afghanistan.

CW3 Boas has been a member of the Genesee Valley Chapter since he became a Warrant Officer, with the encouragement of his Aunt Barbara Green and Uncle Russell Green.

Thank you CW3 Boas for the dedication, professionalism, respect, and compassion while supporting DPAA's mission to provide the fullest possible accounting for our missing personnel to their families and the nation.
