### Have a Question About Your VA Benefits? Try the New 'Ask VA' Portal

The VA launched its "Ask VA" web portal Monday at , offering a single online location for beneficiaries to ask questions and offer suggestions to the department.

Beneficiaries can log in via their <u>ID.me</u>, <u>Premium My HealtheVet</u>, or <u>Premium DS Logon</u> accounts – click the links to learn more about setting up these accounts.

Users also will be able to submit documents through the portal as part of their inquiries. They will receive a reference number for their queries and can enter it into the Ask VA main page to receive any updates.

# **URGENT Health Benefits Open Season Ends Dec 13, 2021**

Changes to TRICARE, Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB), Federal Employees Dental & Vision Insurance Programs (FEDVIP) and MEDICARE plans must be made during open season, with few exceptions. Any enrollment changes you make will go into effect on Jan. 1, 2022. If you make no changes during Open Season your current enrollment will continue into the next year. However, you may want to review your plan for benefits and premium changes against other plans offered for 2022. Check these links...

# A Major Pharmacy Provider Is Rejoining the TRICARE Network. Another Is Leaving

CVS will rejoin the TRICARE pharmacy network as of Dec. 15, while Walmart/Sam's Club will leave the network at the same time, Express Scripts officials told MOAA. With the change, military families will have access to the two largest chain drugstores in the U.S. – Walgreens and CVS – together with many smaller chains and independent pharmacies.

The change is part of the <u>next generation</u> TRI-CARE pharmacy contract. Given the preliminary information available, MOAA believes the quality of the TRICARE pharmacy program will be maintained with these network adjustments and even improved for many beneficiaries.

Beneficiaries who get prescriptions filled at Walmart or Sam's Club will receive a letter notifying them of the change. The letter will include three local TRICARE network pharmacies they might consider using instead, together with suggestions on how to transfer prescriptions most easily to another retail pharmacy, home delivery, or a military treatment facility (MTF) pharmacy.

Families who fill prescriptions at Walmart or Sam's Club will need to move them to another TRICARE network pharmacy location by Dec. 15, 2021.

# -- MOAA Testifies on Benefits Legislation Before House Subcommittee

Cory Titus, MOAA's director of Government Relations for veteran benefits and Guard/Reserve affairs, shared MOAA's support for four pieces of legislation under consideration by the House Veterans Affairs Committee's Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs. He joined representatives from Disabled American Veterans, Women Veteran Social Justice Network, and the Wounded Warrior Project at the virtual hearing, which also included a panel of VA officials.

While MOAA's written testimony to the subcommittee contained the organization's position on more than a dozen pending bills and draft legislation, Titus focused on four bills as part of his remarks:

H.R. 4772: Commonsense Clothing Reform

H.R. 4633: Helping Fraud Victims H.R. 3793: Protecting SGLI and VGLI

H.R. 3402: Parity for Survivors


