

In many cases, it can be a very lengthy process, perhaps years, to gain enough traction and support to become law. A persistent effort is needed, and that's where you come in!

VA Veteran Phishing Warning

If you receive a suspicious email from the Department of Veterans Affairs, **DO NOT** open the email or click on any attachments or links. VA does not send emails asking for personal information, threatening emails, or emails claiming to take adverse actions on claimants or beneficiaries (jail or lawsuits). If you receive any of these emails or are in doubt about any communications appearing to be from VA, please contact VA directly at 1 (800) 827-1000.

Supreme Court Case Challenges VA Rules on Filing Deadlines, Back Pay (Extract) Patricia Kime, Military.com, February 28, 2022

The U.S. Supreme Court has accepted the case of a Navy veteran who believes his Department of Veterans Affairs disability compensation should have been paid starting from the date he left the military rather than the day he submitted his paperwork, a decision that could mean some veterans who waited years to file claims would be eligible for substantial back pay.

When the Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims denied Arellano's claim, he appealed. The Federal Circuit judges then split their decision on the case 6-6, with half saying the equitable tolling policy couldn't be changed, and the other half saying it should be eliminated.

As a result of the split, Arellano's attorneys petitioned the U.S. Supreme Court.

A ruling in Arellano's favor has the potential to affect "thousands of current and future veterans," according to his attorney, James Barney, a graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy and partner in the D.C.-based firm Finnegan.

VA Intends to Propose Nine Rare Respiratory Cancers as Presumed Service-Connected Conditions, March 1, 2022

The Department of Veterans Affairs will propose adding certain rare respiratory cancers to the list of presumed service-connected disabilities in relation to military environmental exposure to particulate matter. If you are a Veteran who has been diagnosed with one of these conditionst the VA has specidied, but have not filed a claim, please notify VA of your <u>intent to file a claim</u>.
