Exciting news! MOAA National now offers "Cheddar Up" as a platform for affiliates (chapters and councils) to establish a digital payment portal for members and donors.

Want to pay your annual chapter dues? Cheddar Up!

Want to donate to one of the chapter dinner designated charities? Cheddar Up!

Want to RSVP and Pay for attendance at a chapter event (dinners, sporting events, etc.)? Cheddar Up!

There are two ways to access the Genesee Valley Chapter (GVC) Cheddar Up portal: via the GVC weblink or, via the GVC QRC; both are shown below.

Note: GVC only sees the last four digits of your credit card when using Cheddar Up.

MOAA's previous online dues payment portal, although functional, left a lot to be desired and didn't provide members, or chapter staff, enough details to confirm what payments were actually for, unless the member sent a follow up email to the treasurer.

Cheddar Up remedies all of that. Additionally, there is no need to sign up for a Cheddar Up account, unless you want one.

GVC Treasurer, Norma Weissend, is our point of contact for the GVC Cheddar Up portal.

Of note, GVC was one of two MOAA chapters nationwide involved in beta testing on the Cheddar Up system to validate its operations and functionality for chapters and councils. 


